Art Trail Map

SBC18 is a partnership between the Saltwater Creek Basketry Group and Friends of the Botanic Gardens. It explores the theme “Seeding Ideas” and brings art to the beautiful Botanic Gardens precinct. The Art Trail takes visitors to unknown places where they will be surprised and delighted to discover artworks amongst our stunning rainforest and exotic gardens.

- **Explore** the whole trail and see all 14 works - takes 45 minutes and requires some hill climbing up the old or new Red Arrow tracks to see numbers 2 to 4
- **Find** the five installations in the main Flecker Botanic Garden – numbers 8 to 12
- **Discover** the Gondwanan Evolution Garden and three art works – numbers 5 to 7
- **Cross over** Collins Avenue to the Fitzalan Garden; the site of the first garden developed in the late 1880s – numbers 13 and 14
- **Wander** along to the Tanks’ main entrance to see the tree adornments made by participants in Saltwater Creek Basketry workshops
